Rate Relief	 A discount of 100% has been extended to all businesses in the Retail, Leisure and Hospitality sector, regardless of Rateable Value, for the year 2020/21.	 MARCH 31
Coronavirus Business Interruption Loan Scheme	 The scheme helps small and medium-sized businesses to access loans and other kinds of finance up to £5 million.	 MARCH 31
Bounce Back Loan Scheme	 The scheme helps small and medium-sized businesses to borrow between £2,000 and up to 25% of their turnover. The maximum loan available is £50,000.	 MARCH 31
Covid Corporate Financing Facility	 The Bank of England can buy short-term debt from larger companies, if they meet the criteria.	Awaiting Confirmation
Sick Pay and Tax Support	 Businesses with fewer than 250 employees at the end of February can claim back full Statutory Sick Pay if their employee is eligible. The government has provided guidance on Statutory Sick Pay claims due to coronavirus. If you are concerned about being able to meet your tax payments due to COVID-19, you should follow government advice to make the HMRC aware.
